MANDATORY REGISTRATION AND TRAINING FOR THE ELECTRONIC GOVERNMENT PROCUREMENT (e-GP) SYSTEM

Dear Valued Suppliers,

The National Treasury is implementing an end-to-end Electronic Government Procurement (e-GP) system across all Procuring Entities in National and County Governments, as directed by His Excellency, the President, in his State of Nation Address on November 21, 2024. This initiative, part of the Public Finance Management Reforms, aims to enhance efficiency, transparency, and value for money in public procurement.

Mandatory Supplier Registration

All Suppliers, Contractors, and Consultants are required to self-register on the e-GP portal, accessible at www.egpkenya.go.ke. Registration is a prerequisite for participating in government procurement processes, effective from **July 1, 2025**.

Supplier Training Opportunities

To facilitate a smooth transition to the e-GP system, the National Treasury is organising weekly supplier registration webinars every Thursday. These webinars are designed to guide suppliers through the registration process and system usage.

How to Participate in the Training:

- 1. **Register for the Webinar**: Visit www.egpkenya.go.ke and navigate to the Supplier Training section to access the registration link. Only suppliers who register will receive an invitation to the webinar.
- 2. Access the Supplier Registration Manual: A comprehensive manual is available on the e-GP portal to assist with registration.

3. In-Person Support:

- Suppliers in Nairobi can visit the e-GP offices at 6th Floor, Room 622, Treasury Building, Harambee Avenue, from 9:00 AM to 4:00 PM for registration assistance.
- Alternatively, visit **The National Treasury desk** at any Huduma Centre during regular office hours.
